1. Introduction to multimedia systems: video and image formats, multimedia compression, networking, storage, I/O, indexing, and retrieval.
2. Multimedia laboratory: software, hardware, various equipment
3. Video and audio capture and playback techniques
4. Multimedia software development tools
5. Multimedia applications
6. Step-by-step procedure in developing multimedia systems: (specification, design, testing, and prototyping)
5. Student projects - developing multimedia presentations.
